Using Option Keys



Designed to use only HE (High-Efficiency) detergent

IMPORTANT: The washing machine is designed for use with only High-Efficiency (HE) detergents. HE detergents are formulated specifically for top-loading washers and contain suds-reducing agents. Always look for the HE symbol when purchasing detergent. Never use more than the maximum amount recommended by the manufacturer of the detergent. While HE detergents are designed for this type of washing machine, care must be used when measuring the detergent.

WATER PLUS

Select this option to add extra water to the wash and rinse cycles for superior results, especially with large or bulky items.

COLD WASHTM

Use this option to eliminate using the built-in water heater booster. For maximum efficiency, wash only small loads (8 lb or 3.5 kg) and use the low spin speed.

EXTRA RINSE

This option will add an extra rinse cycle to the selected cycle. Use this option to help ensure the removal of detergent or bleach residue from fabrics.

FABRIC SOFTENER

The fabric softener is dispensed in the final rinse. Select the FABRIC SOFTENER option to change the final rinse from a spray rinse to a deep rinse.

NOTE: Use the FABRIC SOFTENER or EXTRA RINSE options when selecting the NORMAL (COTTON/NORMAL) or HEAVY DUTY cycles. Options are not available on all models.

Tips for Better Washing


· Group similar items.

For the best washing results and to reduce the possibility of damage to the clothing, care should be taken to sort the clothing into loads that are made up of similar items.

- Pretreat heavily stained areas for best results.
- For best performance, always measure detergent using the measuring device provided by the detergent manufacturer.

 Clothes should fit loosely in the tub under the maximum fill line.
 Loading clothes over the fill line may result in damage to clothing and the washer.

Maintenance

- Use only @ detergent. Using a regular detergent may cause unsatisfactory performance.
- TUB CLEAN (Run this cycle at least once a month.)
 - 1. Open the lid and remove any clothing in the tub.
 - 2. Open the dispenser drawer.
 - 3. Add liquid chlorine bleach or tub cleaner.
 - 4. Close the drawer and washer lid.
 - 5. Select TUB CLEAN and press START/PAUSE button.

CLEANING THE WATER INLET FILTERS

If the washer detects that water is not entering the dispenser, an error message will appear on the display.







Turn off both water taps completely. Unscrew the hot and cold water lines from the back of the washer. Carefully remove the filters from the water inlets, and soak them in white vinegar or a lime scale remover.

Troubleshooting

PROBLEM POSSIBLE CAUSE AND SOLUTION · Wash load may be unevenly distributed in the tub. Stop washer and rearrange wash load. · Adjust the leveling feet. Make sure all four feet are in firm contact with the floor while the washer is · Not all leveling feet are resting firmly on the floor. Vibrating noise in the spin cycle with a load · Make sure that the floor is solid and does not flex. Refer to "Flooring" in the Installation section. · Floor not rigid enough · Fill hose connection is loose at tap or washer · Check hoses.
